The Berks County Chiefs of Police Association is coordinating recruitment of future police officer candidates for Berks County in an attempt to attract the most qualified persons to police the streets of Berks County. Interested candidates may obtain a registration form and the physical performance battery tests at

www.berkscountypolicechiefs.org.

- Completed applications, along with a \$75 check or money order (payable to "BCCPA") must be mailed and received at the address below by Friday, September 12, 2014.
- Written test score results will be posted on the Association's website by Monday, October 6, 2014. Candidates achieving a written score of 70 or higher may proceed to the physical performance test.
- The physical performance test will be Sunday, October 19, 2014 at Alvernia University's Schlager Memorial Field.

The names of candidates passing both segments will be placed on a master police hiring list according to their written score ranking. Participating police departments will develop their individual hiring lists based on a candidate's ranking and on the department's minimum qualifications, such as having Act 120 training prior to employment. Having Act 120 training IS NOT a prerequisite for participating in this process, however, all but two (2) participating police departments require this basic police training.

Interested candidates must be US citizens, 21 years old (except West Reading and Wyomissing, which is 18), have at least a high school diploma or GED and possess a valid driver's license.
