ORDINANCE NO. 572

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EXETER, BERKS COUNTY,  
PENNSYLVANIA, REGULATING THE USE OF MOTORIZED SCOOTERS ON  
PUBLIC STREETS, SIDEWALKS, ALLEYS AND PARKS WITHIN EXETER TOWNSHIP

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Exeter Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. A. MOTORIZED OBJECTS NOT TO BE OPERATED ON PUBLIC STREETS

Immediately upon the enactment of this Ordinance, it shall be illegal for anyone to operate a motorized scooter, or other similar motorized object on the public streets, sidewalks, public alleys and public parks within the Township of Exeter.

B. MOTORIZED SCOOTER

A motorized scooter is defined as a two tandem-wheeled vehicle that is powered by a gasoline engine or electric motor, with or without a seat.

SECTION 2. VIOLATION

Any individual violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each and every offense, and if a minor subject to the penalties as provided by the Youth Aid Panel of Exeter Township.

SECTION 3. SEVERENCE CLAUSE

The provision of this Ordinance shall be severable, and if any of its provisions shall be held to be unconstitutional, invalid or beyond the power of the Township of Exeter to prohibit the decision so holding, the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance shall be construed to be unaffected, and it is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Supervisors of Exeter Township that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, invalid or unauthorized provision or provisions not been included therein.

SECTION 4. REPEALER

Any Ordinance or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5

EFFECTIVE DATE


This Ordinance shall become effective after due advertisement in accordance with the law.
